Hello Pauline

Thank you for your query.

I can confirm the school has a capacity of 105. When planning for school places, Devon County Council uses forecast numbers on roll for 2024, which for Milton Abbot Primary is 80. This leaves a remaining capacity of 25 places. After the impact of approved but unimplemented housing development there would still be a remaining capacity of 21 places.

According to Devon County Council's [Education Section 106 Infrastructure Approach](#), on average, each family dwelling (i.e. dwellings with 2 bedrooms or more) generates 0.25 primary children. This would allow for development of 84 homes before the schools capacity was used up. The 20 homes allocated in the Joint Local Plan would generate 5 primary aged children.
