Subject: comment regarding the Draft Totnes Neighbourhood Plan

Dear Sir/Madam,

We wish to make a corrective comment regarding the Draft Totnes Neighbourhood Plan Regulation 15 version 7/9/2020, as per the current consultation period.

Appendix-B-Local-Green-Spaces-Table page 4 states "*Castle Meadow was gifted to Totnes by the Elmhirst family on the condition that it was preserved as a green space. There is a footpath across the field linking the Castle Hill Allotments to Castle Street.*"

This statement is ambiguous and potentially misleading. The "footpath" is not a public right of way, it is a combination of two contiguous permissive paths: one across Castle Meadow, by assent of Totnes Town Council, and a second via the lane joining Shooters Hill/Castle Street to the eastern gate into the Meadow, by rolling agreement with the owners of Fleetwood House and Shooters Hill House.

We would like to propose, for clarity, that the statement is re-worded thus:-

"Castle Meadow was gifted to Totnes by the Elmhirst family on the condition that it was preserved as a green space. There is a permissive path across the field linking the Castle Hill Allotments to Castle Street."

We would appreciate confirmation that you have received this comment. Thank you.
