I have reviewed the Draft Neighbourhood Plan for Okehampton. The Neighbourhood Plan could refer to surface water management and Sustainable Drainage Systems. Does the Town Council have ambitions for encouraging reusing rainwater?

Sustainable Drainage Systems could include art and displays. Sustainable Drainage Systems could also be shaped in certain ways, such as to represent history (e.g. swales could be formed to look like a leat, if appropriately designed).

For hydro-power, they will need to speak to the Environment Agency.
