South Milton Neighbourhood Plan

They have identified some local flood risk and drainage issues however;

- The document does not include detail on the requirements of suitably designed Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS) in accordance with DCC's SuDS Guidance for Devon.
- There is no mention of the important planning legislation to avoid development in a flood risk area -NPPF

As a minimum we would like to see a statement/policy on the need for Sustainable Drainage, such as

All development proposals should include the provision of a Sustainable Drainage System (SuDS) to ensure the development does not increase the rate of runoff and risk of flooding on and off the site. The use of SuDS features, including ponds, swales, rainwater harvesting, green roofs and soakaways will aim to reduce and/or manage the quantity of runoff and will also improve the water quality, increase biodiversity and provide new amenity. All SuDS to be designed in accordance with Devon County Council's Sustainable Drainage System - Guidance for Devon - Flood Risk Management
